



## Marshall McKinley Myers Sr.

September 9, 1922 - December 15, 2013

Marshall McKinley Myers, Sr., born on September 9, 1922 in San Antonio, Texas to Marshall M. Myers and Virgie Ella Barber went to be with the Lord on December 15, 2013 at the age of 91. He is preceded in death by his beloved wife of 68 years Betty Jo Myers; by his parents and by his brother Erwin Myers. He is survived by his daughter Cheryl M. Robert Evans; son Marshall M. Jr. Linda Myers; grandchildren Darren Jones, Troy Jones, Craig Jones, Christopher Myers and Tiffany Bolton; 10 great-grandchildren and a host of friends. Marshall graduated from Fox Tech High School in 1941 and enlisted in the United States Air Force October 20, 1942. He served 1 1/2 years as an Aviation Cadet training as a pilot. He was later honorably discharged after 3 1/2 years of service. He went to work for Southwestern Bell in 1946 and retired as a Special Service Tech after 36 years of service. He was also a volunteer Telephone Pioneer and was awarded many awards for his involvement in many other community service events. In 1959 he joined the Army Reserve and retired in 1982 with 23 years of service. He achieved the rank of Chief Warrant officer. Marshall served his country proudly in Vietnam and received the Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal, American Theater Medal and the World War II Victory Medal.
