It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of our mother Martha Steves Peet. She lived a good life of 83 years. Martha is preceded in death by her mother Joan Cahill Steves, her father Sam Bell Steves and her sisters Elizabeth Steves Shannon and Joan Steves Devine, all from San Antonio.

Also preceding her was her husband Edwin Jones Peet. Martha and Edwin met when they were 14 years old. She was pitching in a neighborhood softball game in her front yard. Her future husband was in the neighborhood playing with some friends when they were invited to play. Our mother taunted our father at bat. He showed her by drilling the ball right in her face. There was blood everywhere. Our dad ran home, which was about 5 miles, recovered his composure and returned to her house to apologize the same day. They ended up talking for hours and married 4 years later. After 20 years of marriage, Edwin passed, and Martha has longed to be by his side ever since.

Martha was funny, witty and had a way of letting you know exactly how she felt about something, either with a curt look or quick comment. She found joy through the years as a member of the Junior League of San Antonio, serving

as a Docent at the San Antonio Zoo and needlepointing Christmas stockings for her children and grandchildren. She always enjoyed spending time with her children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren and had the opportunity to take all her grandchildren on 'once in a lifetime' trips with her to fabulous places like San Francisco, Chicago, New York City and Yellowstone National Park. She loved everything about nature - especially wolves!

Then Martha suffered a stroke at age 62. It left her with a Cognitive Impairment. She would spend the next twenty-two years trying her hardest to get back to the way she was. She tried to play like nothing happened, but we all knew. It was a hard thing to live through, but we all did what we could do to see that she was happy and comfortable.

Martha is survived by her three children: Edwin James Peet (Susan) of Bulverde, TX, Joanie Peet McMullan (Ashby) of Fair Oaks Ranch, TX and John-David Peet (Randi) of Highlands Ranch, CO.
