Marvin J. House, born November 29, 1921 in Lexington, Texas, passed away on December 31, 2010 at the age of 89. Despite his age of 15, Mr. House enlisted in the U.S. Army and served his Country during W.W. II. He was a POW but later escaped to re-join his unit in battle. He spent many years with the Southwest 4H Club, was a member of the Lytle Ropers Club and a Drill team leader for the Southwest Roughriders. He will be remembered for his generosity in helping kids in need and the influence he brought to the Southwest community. He was preceded in death by his wife, Nelda I. House in 2002 as well as his brother Aubrey and a sister, Betty. Survivors include his daughters: Peggy Brame and Debbie Jeff Bacon; sons: Marvin J. House, Jr., Ronald C. Virginia House, and Johnny D. Kathy House; two sisters: Zelma and Mildred; 7 grandchildren, 6 great-grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
