She outlived almost everyone in her family except her sons Dean W. Greer and Barry D. Greer, her grandchildren Kevin James Greer and Kelli Nicole Franklin (husband Trey); her great grandchildren, Remi Franklin and Rhye Franklin and a host of nephews and nieces.

She was not the life of the party; she was the party. She had so much fun in high school that, upon graduating her sister Blanche asked what she wanted; Mom said "three more years". While we are so sad that Mom is gone, we rejoice knowing that she squeezed every bit of life during her time on earth. Life was an adventure to Mom. After 85 she gave up on men because they only got around in a wheelchair or a walker.

The only thing she loved more than life was her family. To win the argument that she loved her two boys more than we loved her, she answered: "Because

I knew you first.”

If there was one word to describe Mary Lou, it would be “Happy”. Despite the challenges of life, she chose to be happy and because of that, when others looked at her, they became happy too. She always had a smile on her face and a chuckle in her voice.

Ecclesiastes 5:19-20 defines the gift God gave Mary Lou:

“Moreover, when God gives any woman wealth and possessions and enables her to enjoy them, to accept her lot and be happy in her work – this is a gift of God. She seldom reflects on the days of her life, because God keeps her occupied with gladness of heart.
