I watched as my beloved mother, Mary Grumbles, crossed over at 2: 00 am, July 19, 2012 at the age of 89 years at the Ogeechee Area Hospice Inpatient Facility, Statesboro, Georgia. Mary called San Antonio, Texas her permanent home from her birth to Vincent and Bessie Krzesniak on August 9, 1922 until in 2004 when Mary came to live with her daughter, Janice Grumbles, first in Rockledge, Florida and then in Statesboro, Georgia. She was preceded in death by her parents; her three sisters, Sophie Adams, Stella Hedrick Hugg, and Bessie Ellis Dudek; her three brothers, Jim, Joe, and John Krzesniak. She was, also, preceded in death by her children, Carol Ann and James V. Grumbles passing in 1965 at age 18 and 1966 at age 23, respectively and, in 1999, by her loving husband of 58 years, MSgt. William "Bill" V. Grumbles, US Army, Ret. Mary was a people person and worked in customer service at several department stores and finally retiring as a bank teller from Brooks Field National Bank. A devoted mother, she took work breaks to raise her family and, as a devoted Army wife, she wither travelled the world or remained in San Antonio as the stable home base. Mary was a resident of Heritage Inn Health and Rehabilitation facility for the last 5 years. Mary is survived by her daughter, Janice Grumbles, DVM and husband, David Rostal, Ph.D., Statesboro, Georgia and numerous nieces, nephews, great-nieces and great-nephews.
