



Mary Elizabeth Harrison

December 14, 1925 - April 23, 2018

Mary Elizabeth Harrison (nee Stegman) passed peacefully to be with the Lord on April 23, 2018. Born in Baltimore, Maryland in 1925, Mary was a loving wife to Joseph Harrison III, a WW2 veteran with the 101st Airborne division who went on to become a successful Maryland businessman. With an assist from Mary's father John Stegman, a master carpenter, Joseph and Mary designed and built (literally, with their own hands), what became the Harrison family home for the next 47 years. They also traveled frequently with friends and blessed their only child Joseph IV with a mix of strong values, gentle and well-explained discipline, and a dash of inevitable only-child spoiling. After her husband's passing, Mary relocated to San Antonio to be with her son and grandchildren Jessica and Bradley, all of whom survive her. Also surviving Mary is her sister Gloria Breitenbach and beloved nephew Oliver ("Bud") Breitenbach, Bud's wife Elaine, their children John Breitenbach and Kelly Reiter, Kelly's husband Dave and their children Taylor, Morgan and Madie. A memorial service will be held on Wednesday, May 2, 2018 at 7:00 P.M. at Mission Park Funeral Chapel, 1700 SE Military Drive, followed by private interment.
