



## Mary Jane Laurel

June 10, 1935 - February 13, 2006

Mary Jane Laurel, born June 10, 1935 in San Antonio, bravely battled Scleroderma for 23 years before yielding to be in the house of our heavenly father on February 13, 2006. Mrs. Laurel was a devoted wife, mother and grandmother. Besides her home life and household affairs, she had a brilliant Federal Civil Service career sometimes interrupted to raise four children. During her children's schooling, elementary to high school, she was very much involved in PTA functions in all of their schools. She volunteered as a mentor and teacher's aide, and other school activities. All four of her children were involved in extra school curriculum. She started her civil service in 1959 at Randolph A.F.B. then BAMC retiring T Wilford Hall Medical Center, Lackland A.F.B. January 1994. She received numerous commendations and citations from the Air Force. She was preceded in death by her parents Carrie and Leo Sanders, her sisters Irene Sanders, Aurora Sanders, Bridie Sanders, Beatrice Gonzales, Elvira Salinas, and brother Leo Sanders Jr. She is survived by her husband of 47 years, George H.
