May 1, 1932 - May 13, 2009

Mary Lou Quijano passed into eternal rest on Wednesday May 13, 2009. Maria Luisa was born on May 1, 1932 in San Antonio to Vicente and Magdalena Hernandez. She married Carlos Quijano on September 1, 1962. Mary Lou is preceded in death by her parents and five siblings. She is survived by her children Patricia Quijano, Christina and Greg Garcia, Carlos Jr. and Kristel Quijano, Michael and Amanda Quijano, Christopher and Stacy Quijano and 10 grandchildren. Mary Lou lived a life of service to her family and community. She earned her RN from the Galveston School of Nursing and went on to get her BSN at the University of Incarnate Word. Mary Lou served our community through her work with the San Antonio Metro Health District. She also was an early pioneer in bringing the WIC program to the women and children of San Antonio. As a breast cancer survivor, she was a strong proponent of breast cancer awareness, education and prevention. She was also instrumental in starting the mammogram & cervical cancer screening services through the San Antonio Community Clinic. Her mission was to educate women, especially those with limited access and resources. She saw mothers as the backbone of the family and worked to educate women about the importance of caring for themselves so they could be healthy enough to care for their families. Mary Lou was one of the founding members of St. Brigid's Catholic Church. She remained an active member of her church as a Guadalapana, Eucharistic Minister and various other roles until her health no longer allowed her to serve. Our beloved Mary Lou will be missed but her

spirit will continue on through her children, grandchildren and the many lives she touched. A visitation will be from 5:00 pm – 8:00 pm on Sunday, May 17, 2009 with a 7:00 pm Rosary at Mission Park Funeral Chapels North. A 1:00 pm Mass will be celebrated on Monday, May 18, 2009 at St. Brigid's Catholic Church. Interment to follow in Mission Burial Park North. In lieu of flowers donations may be made to The Susan G.
