Mrs. Mary M. Miller, born Dulce Maria Mora in Rockport, Texas on September 14th, 1913, was escorted by angels into the presence of her Lord and Savior the Messiah on October 5th 2010. She was a life-long Texas resident who moved to San Antonio in 1916. She worked her entire life beginning at age five, when she worked in her parent's neighborhood grocery store at 220 Labor Street, an area now part of the Hemisfair Plaza. She subsequently worked in a local egg factory, at the downtown Woolworth's, in the civil service during WWII, and finally as an employee of the State of Texas for 30 years. There, she won several performance awards and was recognized by the local business community for her accomplishments. She retired from State service in 1978. She was preceded in death by her daughter, Mary Kathleen Miller Smarzik, of San Antonio, Texas and a great-grandchild. She is survived by her son, Dr. Michael G. Miller, of Mico, Texas; nine grandchildren; and seven great-grandchildren. She leaves a lasting legacy of love for the Lord Jesus and commitment to His Gospel. She had several good friends who surrounded her during her final years and to whom she wished to convey a loving message of deep gratitude.
