Mary Castellanos Nerio was born on May 24, 1936, in Carrizo Springs, Texas, and passed away on May 21, 2026, just days before her 90th birthday.

For 32 years, Mary worked for various school districts in the Valley. She worked at Harlingen CISD at Central Office. Her sons learned early on that they could never get away with anything at school, because Mary would hear about it. Mary later worked at Med High in the South Texas ISD for Health Professions. She was the registrar and secretary for the Counselors. Students would go out of their way to walk through her office for a kind word, encouragement or a hug.

Mary was an avid sports fan. She first cheered proudly for the Harlingen Cardinals, then the Harlingen Hawks, and was a devoted fan of the Dallas Cowboys and the San Antonio Spurs. She followed her teams with loyalty, enthusiasm, and plenty of opinions. She keenly followed the news and her favorite telenovelas.

Above all, Mary will be remembered for her smile and the joy she brought into every room, the love she freely gave her family, and the countless friendships she carried throughout her life. Her presence was bright, familiar, and deeply cherished, and she will be missed by all who knew and loved her.
