Mary Helen Edwards Norrod was born on April 3, 1929, and passed away on June 6, 2010, after a very short battle with cancer. She was born in Runge, Texas, the second of five children. At 16, she graduated from Taft High School and met her future husband, William A. Norrod. When she was 17, they reconnected and began courting-until she proposed to him. They married the day after she turned 18. Mary was a medical secretary, a model, and an actress in commercials for WOAI-TV, as well as in the movie, "Cactus Barrier". When she had her second child in 1959, she became a full-time, at-home mother. Mary and Bill lived Corpus Christi and Dallas during the early years of their marriage, but settled in San Antonio in 1956, where she lived the rest of her life. Mary was most identified by her beautiful smile, engaging personality, love of reading, wealth of friends, and strong faith.
