



## Master Sgt. Walter Franklin Clarkson

March 26, 1924 - May 22, 2010

Retired Master Sgt. Walter Franklin Clarkson passed away on May 22, 2010. He was 86 years old, a veteran of World War II and the Korean War, and a recipient of the Purple Heart award. An avid walker and outdoorsman, Walter often covered several miles each morning. During this time, he visited old friends and made many new ones. In his latter years, he took up skydiving and woodcarving. He was preceded in death by his parents, Walter W. Clarkson and Rosa B.
