



## Max Edward Reed

December 11, 1925 - March 8, 2012

Max Edward Reed, age 86, passed away on March 8, 2012 after a three year battle with kidney disease. He was born in Long Beach, Calif. on 12/11/1925. While in High School he enlisted in the Army Air Corp in 1943 and was honorably discharged in 1946.
