Maxine Lockhart was called to be with the Lord on September 16, 2013 at the age of 85. She was born on January 24, 1928 to Georgia and Fred Lockhart. Maxine devoted her life to serving the Lord and she shared her knowledge of faith with many. Maxine was appointed by the International Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention and served from 1955 to 1994. She was 27 years old when she went to Nigeria, West Africa, where she served as a teacher in various schools. In most recent years she was a member of Castle Hills Baptist Church and Churchill Baptist Church.
