Mayme Nava, 98, passed away in her home in San Antonio, Texas, March 15, 2019.

She was born September 11, 1921, in St. Paul Texas to Maria Torres-Coy and Claro Coy.

In 1967 she started the first Tuesday of the month rosary. She was a proud member of the Equestrian order of the Holy Sepulcher of Jerusalem.

She was loved by many and will be remembered as a kind and devout Christian. She demonstrated her Christianity daily by her actions and love of her fellow man. She has touched many lives and will be missed by her family and friends.
