Melissa Lolmaugh "Missy", age 62 died on June 17, 2011 in her sister's home in Dallas, TX from pancreatic cancer.

Melissa was born on June 8, 1949 in Detroit, Michigan. Her parents were Mike Miljevich and Doris Miljevich nee Brewer. Melissa graduated from Lakeshore High School in St. Clair Shores, Michigan in 1967. She attended 2 years at Rochester Hills College, a Church of Christ college. During this time she met at 1st United Methodist Church of St. Clair Shores, MI and married Bruce David Lolmaugh her husband of 38 years on February 10, 1973.

Melissa was employed by Michigan Bell Telephone Company later acquired by AT&T, rising to a management position and retiring after 30 years in 1999.

Melissa, her husband and mother-in-law Thelma L. Lolmaugh moved to San Antonio, TX in 2000 and remained settled there until her last illness.

Melissa filled her life with church, friends, family and music her entire life. She had no children of her own but loved children and pets especially cats during her life. Melissa was a big hearted person and she loved to laugh and have fun. She was a person who would do anything for anyone, sometimes to a fault.
