Michael R. Deatherage, 64, born March 10, 1944 in Columbia, Missouri, passed away Friday, August 29, 2008, at his residence in San Antonio. Mike and his wife Donna were married for 45 years and have one daughter, Jennifer, of Katy, Texas.

Mike retired from Union Pacific Railroad after 30 years of service and later worked for Railtex Service Co./RailAmerica in San Antonio, Texas. He was a member of the American Society of Safety Engineers, the National Association of Railroad Safety Consultants and Investigators. He was also a past member of the Board of Directors and Vice Chairman of the Texas Safety Association, and a key member of Operation Lifesaver. Mike was an avid reader, especially of the Civil War era. He also loved to write, and authored books of beautiful poems that usually revolved around Donna and Jennifer.

Mike is survived by his wife, Donna, and daughter, Jennifer, and by his mother Brooksie Deatherage of Marine, Illinois, brothers John and Barry also of Marine, sisters, Nancy Geoppo of St. Jacob, Illinois, Kathy Serrano, Ft. Worth, Texas, and a host of nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his father, Ralph Deatherage, and one sister, Phyllis Wild. Also preceding him in death were his father-in-law and mother-in-law, Lee and Helen Smothers.
