Michael Hamilton Gulley, 63, passed away on Saturday, August 30, 2008, after a valiant struggle with prostate cancer. Born in San Antonio, on June 27, 1945, Mike graduated from Thomas Jefferson High School '63 and went on to earn both his BA and MA from the University of Texas at Austin where he was also a member of the Kappa Alpha fraternity. After completing his degrees, Mike returned to San Antonio and worked as a real estate developer throughout the area. Mike continued this business with his son Loren up to the time of his death.
