February 15, 1942 - June 29, 2024

Michael Caire “Mike” Hoffman, a beloved husband, father, grandfather, brother, and friend, passed away on June 29, 2024, in San Antonio, Texas. Born to Dorothy Burglass Hoffman and Frederick John Hoffman on February 15, 1942, in New Orleans, Louisiana, his life and legacy were deeply interwoven within these two communities he loved and served.

In his youthful glory days, he attended Louisiana State University and served as a reservist in the United States Marine Corps. His career spanned many different tracks, ranging from entrepreneurship to successful corporate stints with the McDonald's Corporation, Sysco, and AT&T. His passions included traveling, cooking, and riding his motorcycle with his wife. He always claimed that God lives in Lake Tahoe, his favorite vacation spot in the world.

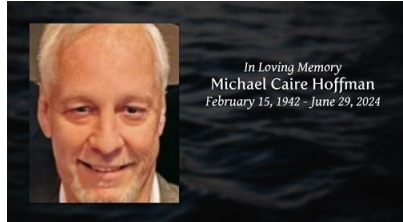

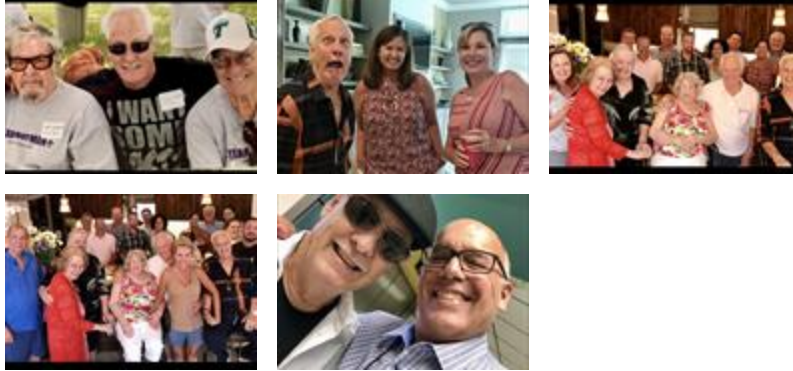
