Michelle Newton passed away on July 5th, 2021 at 54 years old in San Antonio, Texas.

Michelle was born in Laredo, Texas on February 28th, 1967. She received her education at St. Augustine High School and Nixon High School in Laredo, Texas. Michelle lived the majority of her life in Laredo, Texas, and spent the remainder of her years in San Antonio, Texas.

Michelle is survived by her life partner, Oscar Madrigal Jr, and her two kids, Oscar Madrigal III (Danielle Madrigal) and Brittney Madrigal (Rebekah Madrigal), and her beloved boston terrier, Spike. Michelle is preceded in death by her grandmother, Eulalia Ojeda Garcia, and her father, William Billings Newton.

Michelle's personality could light up a whole room, and there wasn't a moment where she didn't have a smile on her face. She loved to have fun and is often described as being bubbly and positive. She also had a lot of faith in God, which was instilled in her by her grandmother, whom she

loved dearly.

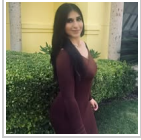
