



## Miguel Angel Ramos

March 4, 1954 - July 30, 2021

Miguel Angel Ramos, beloved son, brother, and friend, was discovered deceased on July 30th, 2021. He was a very private person; kept pretty much to himself, but he had a big heart; especially for those less fortunate, as well as a strong love for animals.

He also had a strong love for his country; joining the United States Air Force Reserve and serving about seventeen years, including serving in a foreign land; the country of Panama in the late 1970s. He was honorably discharged on September 6, 1991.

He was also very supportive of his brother, George. They moved together to Victoria, Texas in 1978. He joined George in Austin, Texas in 1983, and Akron, Ohio in 1988.

He developed an interest in security work while working maintenance and security at the Akron Zoo in 1993, and that's where he met the love of his life, Brandy. They married the following year on May 5, 1994, and were married over twenty-four years. They decided to move down to San Antonio in 2003. Even after they parted ways, after Brandy returned to Akron to care for her ailing mother around 2018, they maintained an amicable friendship. As for his security work, after working at the Akron Zoo, he started working for Pinkerton Security in the Akron area, which in later years changed names to Securitas.

He continued working for Pinkerton/Securitas for over twenty-five years, working at the Toyota Texas plant in the San Antonio area until June of this year; a month before his passing.

Miguel is preceded in death by his loving mother, Josefina Ramirez Ramos; grandparents Romana Perez Ramirez, Maria Aguilar Ramos, Benito Ramos, and Jose Ramirez; numerous aunts and uncles, including James Hart, who was technically a cousin once removed, but who we called Tio Jaime. Tio Jaime was also Miguel's and George's godfather, and a good second father figure.

Miguel is survived by his loving father, Mike Ramos, stepmother Mary Ramos, ex-wife, Brandy; brother George, George's wife, Joycelyn Drozd Ramos; beloved niece, Rachel, and Rachel's boyfriend, Remo, and great niece Adrianna. He is also survived by a few aunts and uncles; as well as numerous cousins, including Rita Torres, who though technically a cousin, was like the sister that Miguel and George never had.

Visitation will be from 5:00 to 6:30 p.m. with the Rosary at 6:30 p.m. will be held at Dellcrest Funeral Home, 2023 WW White Road, San Antonio, Texas; on Monday September 20, 2021. A Funeral Mass will be held at St. Vincent Catholic Church, 164 W.
