



## Milton R. "Bob" Martin

Milton Martin, best known as Bob Martin, passed away at home in the mid afternoon of October 3rd. Bob was born and raised in the city of San Antonio. He joined the Navy in 1964 where he served at the US Naval Security Group in Scotland. Bob attended UTSA where he was a part of the first graduating class of the main campus in 1976. Bob became a CPA in 1982.
