Milton S. Riley, born August 4, 1921, passed into his Lord's hands on September 21, 2008 at the age of 87 years. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife Eileen Riley and survived by sons, Nick Clift Gwen and Danny Clift Kimy; grandchildren, Liz Clift and Katy Clift.

Milton joined the U.S. Army in 1940, transferring into the Army Air Corps during WW II. He was assigned to the 8th Air Force training as a navigator/bombardier, flying 36 missions over Germany and other countries including two missions over Normandy beach on June 6, 1944. He received numerous medals and citations during his service before retiring as a Major in 1961. Milton was a member of Colonial Hills Methodist Church. He will be missed.
