Mrs. Monie Adams was born in Pippa Pass, KY in the Appalachian Mountains. She was a very good wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother. Monie survived the polio epidemic in early 1930's. At the age of 18, she went to Washington, D.C. to attend secretarial school and became a federal employee. She worked at the Pentagon as a secretary to one of the generals and retired in 1969. She married Forrest G. Adams Sr. (USAF Ret'd dec'd 2004) on April 16, 1949.
