MSG Dario L. Ramos, US Air Force Ret, age 88 passed away on Thursday, May 27, 2010. MSG Ramos is a resident of San Antonio, TX. He passed away at home among family and friends. MSG Ramos was born on June 2, 1921 in Comfort, TX. He is the son of the late Mr. Antonio and Santos Ramos of Comfort, TX. MSG Ramos was the second child of 15 brothers and sisters. He faithfully served his country with distinction having received the Bronze Star during WWII as a member of Able Company, 101st Airborne Division. He continued his military service after the war as a member of the US Air Force Reserve and Texas Air National Guard retiring after serving a total of 30 years in the Armed Forces. An avid believer in quality education MSG Ramos ensured that his eight children attended Catholic Parochial schools for the first 12 years of their formal education. MSG Ramos also volunteered thousands of hours in support of city, county and school activities earning the recognition of all the individuals that knew him. He is survived by his wife of 67 years, Mrs. Ofilia P. Ramos, daughter of Mr. Conrado Pena and Susanna Tellez of Eagle Pass, TX; his children John A.
