James R. "Jack" McWilliams passed away on April 7, 2008 in San Antonio, Texas. He was born on October 21, 1919 in Hearne, Texas, to Robert Walter McWilliams and Annie Lee Street McWilliams. He enlisted in the U.S. Army on February 5, 1941 and married the love of his life, Rosalind "Lena" McMullen on September 14, 1945 while in London, England. Jack was later recalled for the Korean Conflict in October of 1950. He earned the American Defense Service Medal; the American Theater Campaign Medal; EAME Campaign Medal with six bronze stars; the Good Conduct Medal; the Victory Ribbon; one service stripe; and three service bars. For the majority of his years in the service, Jack managed NCOA and officers clubs. He honorably served his country with 29 years of dedicated service, and retired from the U.S. Air Force as a Master Sergeant. Jack loved fishing, gardening, playing dominos and spending time with his family. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife, "Lena"; sisters, Emma Kalm, Nell Morris, Wanda Gibson, Lige McWilliams, Hubert McWilliams, Robert McWilliams; and grandson, Benjamin James Schraer. Jack is survived by his daughters, Margaret J. Young and husband, Donald and Attracta M.
