MSGT Terri Lynn Hackney, USAF Ret passed peacefully in her own home with her family beside her on Saturday, February 7, 2015.

She was born June 23, 1957 to Joe and Mickey Wynn Bruscia in Houston, Texas who preceded her in death.

She was a 1975 graduate of Union High School in Biggsville, IL. After graduation, Terri entered the U.S. Air Force and proudly served for 23 years.

One of her most memorable achievements was protecting "Shepherd I", the aircraft carrying St. John Paul II during his visit to San Antonio in 1987.

During her years of military service, she was awarded a Baccalaureate Degree in Criminal Justice from Troy State University. She later was awarded a Master's Degree in Educational Psychology from the University of Oklahoma.
