



Myra Lee Hild Kraft Ullrich

Myra Lee Hild Krafft Ullrich was born September 21, 1924, in San Antonio, Texas and passed away June 3, 2024 in Denton, Texas, at the age of 99. She was the daughter of Albert H and Ida A (Schick) Hild. On January 2, 1946, she married Edward Walter Krafft at St. John's Lutheran in San Antonio. During the next 29 years, Myra transferred her church membership to Peace Lutheran Church where she served as Council and Church Secretary. She was active in the Lutheran Church Women and the choir. For 12 years, she was the Registrar at Sam Houston High School and was a member of the Teacher Retirement System. Her husband, Edward, preceded her in death on May 30, 1972. On December 16, 1975, she married Alton W. Ullrich at First Protestant Church in New Braunfels where she lived for the next 37 years. During these years, she and Alton worked part-time, volunteered, and traveled. Myra served on the Board of Trustees of the Fraternal Order of the Sons of Hermann, Lodge #21, Secretary of AARP, Chapter #1823, and was a member of the Eagles Auxiliary #2999. The last 10 years, Myra resided at The Carriage House Assisted Living in Denton, Texas. Myra was preceded in death by husbands: Edward W. Krafft and Alton W. Ullrich; father and mother Albert H.
