Nan B. Briggs, 87, formerly of Cherry Hill, New Jersey passed away early Wednesday, morning December 10, 2014 at Guadalupe Regional Medical Center in Seguin, TX.

Born in Berwick, PA., October 16, 1927 she was the daughter of the late John and Maude Kramer Lewis. She resided in Seguin, TX. for the past 2 years where she was a resident of Nesbit Living and Rehabilitation Center, formerly from Linderman Avenue, Cherry Hill, NJ.

Nan was a member of the First Presbyterian Church, Merchantville, NJ. She also was a member of the Women's Association and Thrift Shop. Nan enjoyed working in her flower garden, listening to country music, sewing and doing crafts.
