Natalie Nadine Sutton was born at home on June 23, 1924 to Horace Shelton Sutton and Hannah Elizabeth Sutton in Melvin, TX. She started school at the age of five and graduated Magna Cum Laude from Hardon-Simmons University before her nineteenth birthday. She began her career in education a few weeks later teaching English in San Angelo. She also taught in Mertzon, Midland and San Antonio.

She met her future husband Sherrill Arvin, a U.S. Army Air Corps Pilot-in-training on a weekend trip home. They married in 1947 and had their three children while living on a ranch near Melvin. She was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother and great-grandmother.

She was a devout Christian and associated with Cornerstone Church all the way back to Trinity Assembly in 1973. Her strong faith began at an early age in the Free Church at Melvin which was built by Swedish Immigrants. Through the years she reflected on memories of her Swedish grandparents simple lifestyle and daily reading of God's Word, an influence that has now become a legacy to a sixth generation.

She died peacefully in her sleep at her daughter's home January 2, 2019. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband Sherrill T. Arvin, and her brother Leland Sutton. She is survived by her sister Cary Nan Rauch, her
