August 4, 1924 - October 29, 2005

Neatis Ethelda Carroll Douglass of San Antonio passed away, Saturday, October 29, 2005, at the age of 81. She was born in Bristol, VA, the only child of the late Emma Bell Malone Carroll and the late Joseph Emory Carroll. She was a long time resident of San Antonio who loved her family above all else and cherished her friends and her church. She enjoyed needlework and researching family genealogy.
