Col. Newton Wallace Powers, USAF Ret., born May 18, 1918, went to be with the Lord after a prolonged illness on Sunday, February 13, 2005, at the age of 86. Mr. Powers was born in Amarillo, Texas, was a former resident of Galveston, Texas and had lived in San Antonio most of his life. He was married to his beloved wife, Thelma Lee Powers, for 50 years who preceded him in death.
