Nicholas Joshua Weaver, 29, of San Antonio TX, died April 23, 2017 unexpectedly, but peacefully, in his sleep.

He was born December 31, 1987, attended St Paul's Catholic School before graduating from Central Catholic High School in 2006. He received his Bachelor's degree from Texas A&M University in Corpus Christi and a Master's degree from A&M University of San Antonio. Nick was employed at TTWN (Total Traffic & Weather Network), an iHeart Media company. Nick enjoyed going to the movies, on-line gaming, and loved watching Dr. Who, the Spurs and his Green Bay Packers. Most of all, Nicholas loved people, he never met a stranger. 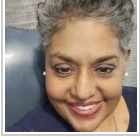
