Nicolas Casas, born May 25, 1930 in Graytown, passed away on July 29, 2019. He enjoyed national politics, Dallas Cowboys, San Antonio Spurs, and was an avid reader. Nicolas was a devout catholic and member of Mission San Jose. He was a six generation Tejano, and descendent of Native Americans who lived at Mission San Jose. Nicolas worked 37 years for the U.S. Postal Service. He was also a great grandson of Canuto Diaz, a defender in the Siege of Bexar before the Alamo battle. Nicolas is preceded in death by his son Nicolas Jr., mother Juanita T. Casas, siblings Margarita Saldana, Herminia Machado, Josie Villarreal, Aurelia Almandarez and David Casas. He is survived by his loving wife of 68 years Elvira U. Casas, daughter Linda U. Casas, grandson Matthew Casas, granddaughter Lauren Casas, and daughter-in-law Debbie Casas, numerous nieces, nephews, and a host of friends.
