Nila June Yount Jordan died peacefully at age 86 on August 8, 2010 while at the Odyssey Hospice surrounded by family and friends after a long battle with congestive heart failure. Born June 25, 1924 in Tatum, New Mexico in a mud and rock house with half wooden and half dirt floors. As she grew, she rode her horse, Cupid to school for several miles. She and her late sister, Francis, had good times with Nila's pet raccoon when living on a very small farm during the great depression. She wanted to preserve those times and in 1988, Nila plead to the Kansas State Historical Society for preserving of her father's barn as a Land Mark. The barn is currently preserved along with a Bed and Breakfast. She was in the U.S. Cadet Nurse Corps of World War II where she met and cherished her husband, Paul Glendon Jordan; until his death in 2007. She stood by her husband and his love for boating; joining him in a life-time of boat restoration and water activities - even though she was deathly afraid of water. At 18, she was a switchboard operator for Bell Telephone and later an RCA Service Company secretary retiring after 25 years. Nila was a member of the Woodland Christian Church until she joined Castle Hills Christian Church and Reverend Ed Skidmore where she found spiritual strength and guidance, and a lasting church family.

Nila is survived by her children, Linda, Paul Rane and Susan; 6 grandchildren; 13 great-grandchildren; and nieces and nephews.
