Noah Sebastian Cullum (Seby) was born in Melbourne, Australia on November 22, 2002 and died on July 5, 2019 at the age of 16. He is preceded in death by Junior Cullum (Grandfather) and Marty Rogers (Uncle). He is survived by his parents Brad and Marlene, his siblings Jordan, Hannah Lee and Samuel. He passed away in Sallisaw, Oklahoma as a result of an ATV accident.

Visitation will be held at Central Catholic High School in San Antonio, TX on Thursday, July 11th at 5:00 pm. followed by rosary at 7:00 p.m. The funeral mass will take place Friday, July 12th at 1:00 p.m. at St. Matthew Catholic Church (10703 Wurzbach Rd.) with internment at Fort Sam Houston National Cemetery immediately following. Seby was a military brat. He lived in Australia, Kansas, North Carolina, Italy, Hawaii and Texas. He loved to travel with his family and friends. He was always determined when he set his mind to a goal. He received his First Communion in Hawaii and was an Altar Server in Hawaii and Texas. He earned his black belt in Karate at the age of 10. He was a competitive gymnast and sacrificed playtime and other sports to train. He played football, golf and ran cross country at St. Matthew Catholic School and swam for the Central Catholic swim team. Seby was a state finalist in PSIA for drawing. He earned Honor Roll recognition every quarter of his school career. Seby was the student council president at St. Matthew and initiated a safety program for carpool after he saw the need. Seby loved JROTC at Central Catholic where he earned the rank of second lieutenant. He

was a proud member of the PT Striker Team and the Raider Challenge Team. Seby was also a certified lifeguard and worked at his neighborhood pool. Seby had a lot of hobbies and interests throughout his short life. He was very creative and loved drawing and making videos. He was also an accomplished pianist and drummer. He had a beautiful singing voice but was too shy to let anyone hear it. He also loved fishing, hunting, swimming, surfing and video gaming. He especially loved to eat Sour Patch Kids (or any sweet) and cereal. We remember Seby most for his sensitive heart, empathy, creativity and quick wit. He loved to make people laugh and was always playing practical jokes. He would surprise his family with a swan made out of an apple on the kitchen counter. He had a well-formed conscience which was heavily influenced by his family, church and catholic education. He attended reconciliation weekly of his own accord.
