Norma Lee Brown passed away on April 27, 2018 in Houston, Texas. Norma was born in San Antonio September 28, 1932 and attended Brackenridge High School, where she was a member of the Purple Jackets. Following business school, Norma worked for over 40 years in the public education field, first as a manager of the accounting department at the San Antonio Independent School District and then at the Region 20 Education Service Center, where she served as a consultant in public education finance to a number of school districts in South Texas. Norma was always devoted first and foremost to her family. Following her retirement, she was a companion and caregiver to her parents and to her husband of 53 years, J.P., until his death in 2010. Norma and J.P. were members of the Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd for over 50 years, where Norma served as a member of the Altar Guild. Norma loved growing flowers and plants of all kinds and her backyard was always the envy of the neighborhood. In 2012 Norma moved to University Place Retirement Community in Houston, to be closer to her son and his family, but her love of San Antonio never waned. Norma was preceded in death by her parents, Edward and Lucille Steffler and her husband J.P. She is survived by her son Dr. Richard Brown and his wife Dr. Laura Sulak, grandson Matthew Brown, nephew David Keene and family, and

cousin Carol Warncke and husband John.
