Norma Kay (Brand) Smith, born June 13, 1940, went to be with Jesus early in the morning, June 16, 2024, having just turned 84 years old.

She was born and resided most of her life in San Antonio and was the youngest of three children of Henry and Martha Brand. She graduated Harlandale High School, class of 1958. At 18, she married Jerry Robert Smith, and together they had three children. They were married 58 years until Jerry's death in 2017.
