Norman Wenske passed away in the early hours of September 29, 2014 after a courageous battle with cancer. He served honorably for 6 years in the US Navy, serving on the USS Estes and USS George K. McKenzie, during the Vietnam War. He was born May 18, 1938 to Bennie Wenske and Esther Wagener Wenske. He was preceded in death by his father. In 2002 Norman voluntarily retired his position in the Circulation Department of the New York Times. He then spent the following 10 years as the primary caregiver for his mother.
