Mr. Oliver Quintero Casanova, born on March 25, 1946 in Elmendorf, TX. Peacefully went to be with our Lord surrounded by family on November 22, 2009 at the age of 63 after a long battle with Heart Disease. He was a direct descendant of Jose Antonio Perez Casanova of the 16 Original Families of the Canary Islands in Spain that founded San Antonio in 1731. He was the great great grandson of P. L. Buquor, former Mayor of San Antonio circa 1863 and a member of the Texas Rangers in 1842 under the command of Captain Jack Hayes. Mr. Casanova was preceded in death by his parents, Simon McLane Casanova and Amada Quintero Casanova , daughter Jessica Palma; brothers Jimmy and Luis Casanova; sister, Mary Lou Guzman.
