Oliver Fredrick Weise was born in Cottage Grove, a subdivision of Houston, Texas, on July 12, 1934. He went to be with his Lord on November 21, 2016, at the age of 82. He was a favorite among all who knew him. He once remarked about himself that he should have been a comedian because he liked to make people laugh.
