



## Olivia A. Negrete

February 28, 1930 - September 3, 2020

Olivia Arriaga Negrete went peacefully to be with the Lord on September 3rd at the age of 90. She was born in New Braunfels, Texas on February 28, 1930, in a time when life was not easy, the struggles that came in her early life made her kind, loving and most of all, a very strong woman. With only an 8th grade education Olivia was incredibly smart, she managed to become a very talented seamstress, help raise her siblings, and as single woman in her early thirties, owned her own home. This was unheard of at the time. In early 1963 Olivia was introduced to her future husband by her co-worker and friends, Beatrice & Jimmy Negrete (Tony's Brother) and the couple were soon married on December 7, 1963. The birth of her two sons followed in the next two years. Olivia loved music, dancing, and entertaining at family gatherings and always shined as an excellent host.

At the age of 50, in her prime of life, Olivia was diagnosed with a very aggressive form of Metastatic Breast cancer and she was given slim chances of survival but Olivia prevailed. Olivia's incredible faith in God and positive attitude was the driving force that allowed her to recover and spend the next 40 years with her family. This test of love and strength made Olivia and Tony inseparable throughout their 56 years of marriage. Olivia touched many people in her 90 years and as she said many times to her sons don't ever feel sorry for her as God gave her everything she needed.... FAITH!

Olivia is preceded in death by her parents Max and Maria Arriaga, her brothers Fred, John, and Jesse Arriaga. Survivors include her loving husband

of 56 years Mr. Antonio (Tony) P. Negrete, her two sons and daughter in-laws: John and Catherine Negrete and Michael and Christian Negrete.
