March 10, 1926 - August 25, 2021

Orville Kenneth "Bub" Lincoln, 95, loving and devoted husband, father and grandfather passed away on Wednesday, August 25, 2021. Born in San Antonio, Texas on March 10, 1926, Orville was a caring, fun-loving person who always put the needs of his family and friends first.

After graduating from Central Catholic High School in 1943, Orville served in the Army Air Force during World War II as a radar and weapons repair technician in India. Upon being honorably discharged, Orville returned to San Antonio, where he met Virginia Gilchrist, the love of his life, in 1948, while both were working at Sears & Roebuck in downtown San Antonio. Married in 1950, they stayed in San Antonio, where they raised their five children. After retiring from a 30-year career with City Public Service in 1984, Orville enjoyed pursuing his hobbies, and spending quality time with his wife, children and grandchildren. He is preceded in death by his wife of 67 years, Virginia Lorene Lincoln; his parents, Uncas Patrick Lincoln and Margaret Gloria Vallance; brother, James P. Lincoln, and sister, Ann L. Burgasser. He is survived by his children: Kathleen M. Baker (Bill); Linda L. Jones (Willis); Judy A. Lincoln; Martha J. Smith (Mark); and Charles A. Lincoln; grandchildren: Michael D. Baker; Michael J.
