Oscar M. Lopez, 71, passed away peacefully on Sunday, 29th December 2019 at his home in San Antonio, Texas after bravely battling a long illness. With him at the time of passing were his wife and dear loved ones.

Oscar was born on February 16, 1948 in El Paso, Texas. He was a graduate of Jefferson High School, class of 1966. After graduating, he enlisted in the US Army and served two tours in Vietnam in 1967 and 1968. He honorably discharged and was a recipient of the Vietnam Service Medal with three Bronze Stars, the Vietnam Campaign Medal, the Good Conduct Medal, Bronze Star Medal and Purple Heart. He later retired from the US Post Office after 15 years of service.

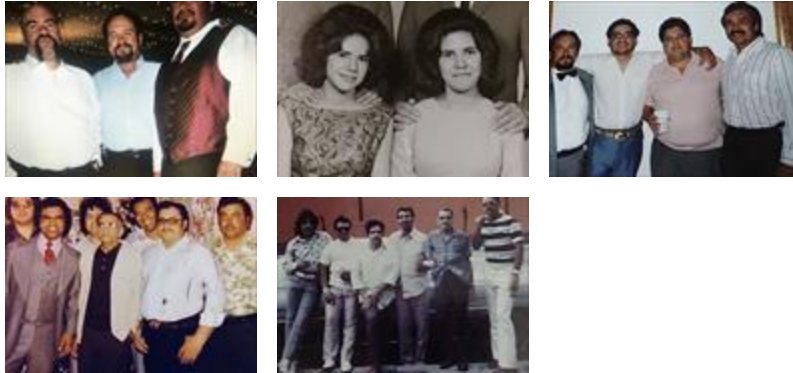
