Ovi became a guitar repair expert in his later years, where he had an accumulation of over 40 guitars, over 10 guitar amps, countless cases, and every tool necessary to restore it to the best guitar you'd ever played. He was so proud of his guitars. He ran a small business buying, repairing, then selling them, and he was insanely good at it.

He will be honored at Mission Park at 3401 Cherry Ridge Dr on Wednesday, February 16th, with visitation from 5pm-6pm, and Celebration Of Life from 6pm-7pm. He will be laid to rest at San Fernando Cemetery II on Thursday, February 17th at 10am."
