



## Pat Arthur Wagner

December 5, 1957 - March 31, 2021

Pat Arthur Wagner, age 63, went to be with the Lord on March 31, 2021.

Pat was born on December 5, 1957 in San Antonio, Texas. He lived in his childhood home until his death.

The Texas coast around Rockport and Corpus Christi was special to Pat, a place he visited frequently throughout his life. He loved being around water and learned to swim at an early age. His mom and dad took him on fishing trips, and he enjoyed camping with his family.

A self-educated lifelong learner, he had interests in reading, math and English. He was intrigued by appliances and how they functioned. He also had a love for classic cars, especially Fords, and the Edsel was among his favorites. Pat's tenderness for animals led the family to have many legendary pets. Among the dogs, horses, birds, fish, a cat and Nancy the goat, there was Butter, a dog who also liked the beach and who was his best four-legged friend. His latest pets include a rescue dog named Lady Bug and two of her children, Sable and Miss Cuddles. They were a great source of comfort during the last few years of Pat's life.

His life was characterized by long battles with mental and physical illness. He was an incredible fighter with an inspiring spirit of perseverance that became his legacy. His empathy for others with mental illness and open struggles served to reveal in us all our need for help and compassion.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Lillie Mae Wagner, and his father, Lane Wagner. He is survived by his Sister Sharon Grohman (Alvis), his aunts

Mary Ann Robbins, Sylvia Sralla and Temple Sralla; double cousins Veronica Lachappelle and Bonnie Ochsner, numerous other cousins and family members and special friends.

Visitation will be held at Dellcrest Funeral Home on Thursday April 8, 2021 from 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. with a Rosary to be recited at 6:30 p.m. and will be live streamed. A Funeral Mass will be held at St. Benedict Catholic Church on April 9, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. Interment will be at Ft. Sam Houston National Cemetery on May 3, 2021 at 9:30 a.m.

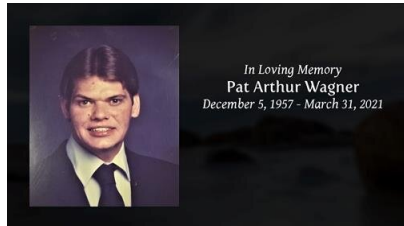
