Patricia Grant passed on to eternity on June 24, 2024, at the age of 91.

Patricia was born in the French speaking town of Edmundston, New Brunswick, Canada on July 26, 1932. She was raised by her mother Febrenie (Michaud) Cyr, and then cared for her mother throughout her marriage until her mother passed. Prior to her marriage she graduated from New Brunswick Teacher's College and taught elementary students at the Ecole Grand-Rivere in Saint Leonard, New Brunswick. She later earned a B.A. degree from Wichita State University.

She is predeceased by her husband Thomas A. Grant, to whom she was married for 67 years. She kept the family healthy and together despite the challenges of the day, fulfilling the adage that the most difficult assignment is that of the military spouse.
