Patricia Ann Johnston, age 90, passed away peacefully on August 20, 2025, in Corpus Christi, Texas. She was born on July 26, 1935, in Toledo, Ohio, to Charles Alfred Burns and Francis Isabel (Jones) Burns.

In July 1952, while visiting San Antonio, Patricia met the love of her life, Jerone, on a blind date. It was truly “love at first sight.” After returning to Ohio to finish her senior year of high school, Patricia received an engagement ring in the mail from Jerone. Following her graduation, the two were married on June 20, 1953, at First Baptist Church in San Antonio.

After Jerone suffered an injury that led to an honorable discharge from the Army, they returned to Texas A&M University so he could complete his degree.
