



## Patricia Anne Skelton Mallory

April 9, 1927 - May 4, 2019

After joyously celebrating her 92nd birthday, Pat passed peacefully and quietly to her Lord surrounded by her children in San Antonio, Texas where she had lived the past four years. She was born in Cincinnati, Ohio where she spent her childhood and graduated from Walnut Hills High School in 1945. She attended Barnard College and eventually graduated in 1950 from the University of Cincinnati. While at UC she met a former Walnut Hills classmate, Hal Mallory, who became her husband of 66 years until his death in July 2016. After starting her short teaching career, Pat and Hal moved for his work with General Electric Company in Tampa, Florida and again, after accepting a transfer to the wilds of Dallas, Texas, where they elected to stay and raise their family. In 1952 Hal started his own business and established what was to become Mallory Lighting Associates. Pat supported this effort by raising their four children as Hal traveled the country to grow the family business and then she went back into the workplace, in retail sales, with Titcher-Goettinger and Sears Roebuck. Later she worked by keeping the books as the family business continued to expand.

Pat loved music and was an accomplished opera quality soprano. She sang in her high school and college choirs and supported local community theatre in Dallas by singing in musicals. She enjoyed watching football, baseball and golf. She and Hal were avid tennis players and supported junior tennis by hosting visiting players in their home. Pat also loved to bowl and played with great success in ladies' bowling traveling all over the country in league and

tournament play with her many bowling friends. She played bridge with great skill and enthusiasm and enjoyed games of 31 with her family. Pat was always ready to go to the casinos to play blackjack and feed the one-arm bandits. Pat's greatest pleasure was her family and spending the holidays together. She was a family Christmas fanatic which she passed on to her children and enjoyed hosting 4th of July parties and "Nana Camp" for her granddaughters. She was a huge pet lover and was especially fond of her Border Collie, Sally. She was predeceased by her parents, Charles Gregory Skelton and Anne Sullivan Skelton and her husband, Harold I. Mallory. She is survived by her children, Harold D. Mallory (Gloria) of San Antonio, Texas, Ann M. Markl (Marty) of Rowlett, Texas, Patric S. Mallory (Lynette) of Magnolia, Texas and Mary E.
