Patrick Bennett Dale of San Antonio, TX passed away on May 24, 2024 at the age of 80 years old. He was born November 5, 1943 in McAllen, TX to Oscar and Mary Dale (deceased). A lifelong Texan, Pat lived in Sharyland, Eagle Pass, Carrizo Springs, Mission, Harlingen, Kerrville, Tarpley, Medina, Bandera, and most recently San Antonio.

A veteran of the U.S. Navy, Pat served aboard the U.S.S. Durant stationed in Honolulu, Hawaii. He joined the U.S. Border Patrol in 1967 and retired after 30 years of government service. After retirement, he worked as a U.S. Marshall at the San Antonio Courthouse. In addition, Pat was a Master Mason and lifelong member of the Grand Lodge of Texas.

Among many hobbies over his lifetime, he held a light aircraft pilot license, loved to fish, play golf and softball, and barbeque with friends and family. Pat loved to watch sports, and despite Jerry Jones, he remained a dedicated Dallas Cowboys fan.

Pat was kind and loving and always put his family first; he loved all animals, especially his sweet dog Lisa who is waiting for him.

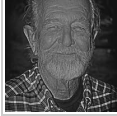
